"God's Power Towards Them Who Believe"

"And what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places" (Ephesians 1:19-20).

On Sunday evenings at the Chapel we have been learning from the book of Ephesians. This particular Bible book describes in detail the wondrous salvation that God has given through Jesus Christ to all who believe in Him. The apostle Paul wrote this letter to the Christians of Ephesus to remind them of their salvation and to let them know that he was praying for them. The Scripture above is just one part of his prayer for these Christians. The content and intent of this prayer is incredibly encouraging, so I'd like us to think about it.

We are told here that God's power is "toward us who believe" in Christ. This means we are the recipients of His mighty power! God's power is directed toward us. We are the beneficiaries. Furthermore, we are told that the power that God works toward us is the same power that God "worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places."

There is a vast difference in physical power as compared to spiritual power, but perhaps an illustration about physical energy will help us understand God's power towards Christians. Scientists tell us that in just one second, our sun produces enough energy to provide for all the energy consumption needs of the entire earth for the next one million years. We also know that God designed the sun to radiate vast amounts of physical energy so that the recipients of the suns power might achieve the purpose for which God designed them. The oceans, the plants, the animals, the atmosphere and we ourselves benefit from the sun's power. We need the suns power or we can't survive in our present situation on earth.

Now let's think about **the exceeding greatness of God's power**, which is towards every born-again Christian. Just as God's creation benefits from the power of the sun, we benefit from the power of God. It was God's power which drew us to Christ. You and I would have never come to Christ unless the Father brought us to the Son (John 6:44). It was God the Holy Spirit who convicted us of our sin and pointed us to the Lord Jesus Christ. And now that we are Christians it is God's power that keeps us! Philippians 1:6 tells us: **"He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ."** God began the work, God keeps working in us, and God's power will complete His work in us!

God's power toward us is so powerful, He will one day bring us into His presence with a glorified body. We are told in Philippians 3:21 that when the Lord Jesus returns in glory, "He will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself'. Now that is some power! And this power is towards all Christians. And we receive the benefit of His great power!

Brothers and sisters, the same power that raised Jesus from the dead is working in you! God is working in you to do His good pleasure (Philippians 2:12-13). He that is in you is greater than he that is in the world (1 John 4:4). His power towards you will make sure that you will one day be holy and blameless before Him forever (Ephesians 1:4).

Let us rejoice in God's great power towards us! And let us pray like the apostle Paul did, that our brothers and sisters in Christ will be granted by God this spiritual understanding.





Nortonville Spotlight Alice Shumake

One of the saints of Nortonville Chapel we'd like you to know better is someone who has been associated with the Chapel for many years, Alice Shumake.

Alice was born in Spring Lake to George and Gladys Chittenden. She was the second youngest of eight children. She kept busy on the family farm, spending hours hoeing, picking berries, and helping her family.

After attending Patchin School through the 8th grade, she went to High School in Grand Haven. At that time, Spring Lake didn't have it's own high school. Though she would have liked to have been involved in after-school activities, she couldn't because she didn't have the transportation. Her favorite school subject was math, and she was able to use her math skills after graduation in the accounting field. One of her jobs was with Eagle Ottawa, a leather manufacturing company that was later called Albert Trostel.

Alice's parents didn't take her to church when she was young. She remembers that Ted and Ethel Bunker used to pick her up and bring her to the Nortonville Chapel when she was a "tween." Her attendance wasn't regular, but she was taught the good news of Christ in the Sunday School. She also remembers a little lady named Rose Young at Nortonville, who lived next door to the Chapel. Rose was very faithful to the services and could be seen walking over to the chapel whenever it was time for the services to begin. She also remembers Jo VanEizenga, who was also very involved in the Lord's work.

When she was in her twenties, Dave Chittenden and Jack VanEizenga visited Alice at her home and presented the gospel to her. It was on that day that she put her faith in Christ and was saved. Her favorite Bible verse is John 3:16.



One activity Alice enjoyed when she was younger was dancing. She did waltzes, polkas and the two-step. It was at a dance that she met a nice man named Boyd Shumake. After a few years they married and had a happy marriage. Boyd was a Christian whose father who was a preacher. Boyd and Alice enjoyed camping together in their Class A motor home, and often travelled to Boyd's home state of North Carolina. Boyd went home to be with the Lord on New Years Eve in 1999.

The American House in Spring Lake has been Alice's home the last fourteen years. It was formerly named Oak Crest, and was independently owned and "homey". She says that it is now run more like a business.

When she was asked what advice she would give, Alice had this to say: "Life is short, so make sure you are more caring towards people, especially family members. Be sure to trust in the Lord when you think things are not right. Just trust that He knows that it will turn out right for you." Alice also said, "I am still learning that I need to do more trusting in the Lord myself. I am looking forward to going to be with the Lord. In the meantime, I'd like to be happier in the Lord."
